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Agora Summer School Fees & Schedule

Welcome to our amazing summer learning programs! These forms need to be filled out as soon as possible because spaces will fill up fast. The final date for submission of all forms is **June 28th**, 2024. However, we will be accepting enrollment as early as **February 2024**. Spots fill up quickly, so apply as soon as you can.

Please note that we will still be accepting applications for summer learning after that date, if there is availability and it will always be on a first come, first serve basis. The ratio is 1:8 for educator/student.

Summer school will run from July 2nd to August 23rd, 2024 (8 weeks) - Please check off whether you would like July or August or both for enrollment. Students must sign up for a week at a time.

Fees:

Fee per week is **\$200** for students in grades one to four (K-8)
Entire Summer is **\$1500** (\$20 discount for sign up)

Agora Prep is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage of such equipment. Please emphasize the importance of the student taking care of their property. We require that our students adhere to expectations and respect the rights and well-being of all individuals. We expect the cooperation of parents and guardians in upholding our standards. We believe that families and the School share the task of establishing the right balance of freedom and responsibility, realistically and consistently.

DISCIPLINE POLICY

We respect our student fully and completely at Agora Prep. We do not believe in time-outs, yelling or corporal punishment. Our main methods of discipline include the following:

- Redirection and Distraction, Meditation and Emotional Expression
- Reward systems that positive reinforce acceptable behaviour
- Natural consequences (with reasoning and logic, we do not force students to make decisions, we just guide them and lay out consequences of their decisions)
- Logical consequences (if you hit your friend, you will be asked to move elsewhere in the room)
- Quiet and Calm Down corner (for students to **choose** to visit when they need to calm down)
- Physical restraining of a child who demonstrate self-injurious behaviour or aggressive behaviour towards other children/staff and constant communication

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Suspension and/or Expulsion

- Families and students may be **terminated** from the program or any of the following reasons:
- Abusive treatment of instructional, administrative or any staff of the school (physical, emotional, sexual harassment)
- Abusive or violent behaviour towards students in the learning environment (physical, emotional, sexual harassment)
- Foul, abusive, inappropriate, or lewd gestures or discriminatory treatment in any way towards anyone or the environment
- A specialized developmental issue or severe undisclosed diagnosis where student would not flourish in the current environment
- Failure to pay school fees and participate in activities
- Detection, threat or discovery of harmful materials at school that can potentially cause illness or death (cigarettes, drugs, alcohol, explosives, weapons, or poisonous materials)
- Stealing, gambling, cursing, destruction of school or student property and defying authority resulting in harm to self or others

Student Illness

If a student feels ill while at Agora Prep, the administrative staff will contact the parents promptly for pick up of the student. For the safety of the other students and staff of the school, a doctor's note will be required to return to school. This ensures that any contagious or potentially harmful diseases to immunocompromised members of our school do not spread within our environment. To protect your child and others, we ask if a child is exhibiting symptoms of a cold (sore throat, cough, sneezing, watery eyes, lethargy, diarrhea) that they remain at home. Students given medication to come to school will be sent home after it wears off. So please protect your child and others from spreading illnesses and keep them home if they are ill.

Use of Medication

Medication will not be given to any student without proper documentation which can be attained from the front office. Outdoor recess, fresh air and exercise are especially important to help a child be ready to learn. All students are expected to be well enough to go outside. If there is a request for a child to be excused from outdoor activities (unless otherwise stated in the initial enrollment for accommodating of a specific special need) then the student should remain home. **If a student is too ill to go out, they should be at home to fully recover.**

Outdoor Activities and Sports

Please ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for weather conditions with an additional set of spare clothing in case of accidents, messy exploration, or unintended incidences.

Playground Accidents

In the event of a playground accident, the accident (however minor) should be reported to the yard duty instructor or supervisor as soon as possible. Parents will be asked to sign a report to acknowledge being told of the event.
